

Downloading a Distributed Questionnaire

 - The questionnaire is distributed online by Mapi Research Trust
 - You are an academic user and do not receive specific funding for your study
 - Or you intend to use the questionnaire in individual clinical practice or research study

Step 1: Sign up for free

1. Go to <https://eprovide.mapi-trust.org/login>
2. If you already have an account, enter your credentials and click **Login**
3. If you are not registered yet, click **Free Registration**. Then complete and submit the registration form

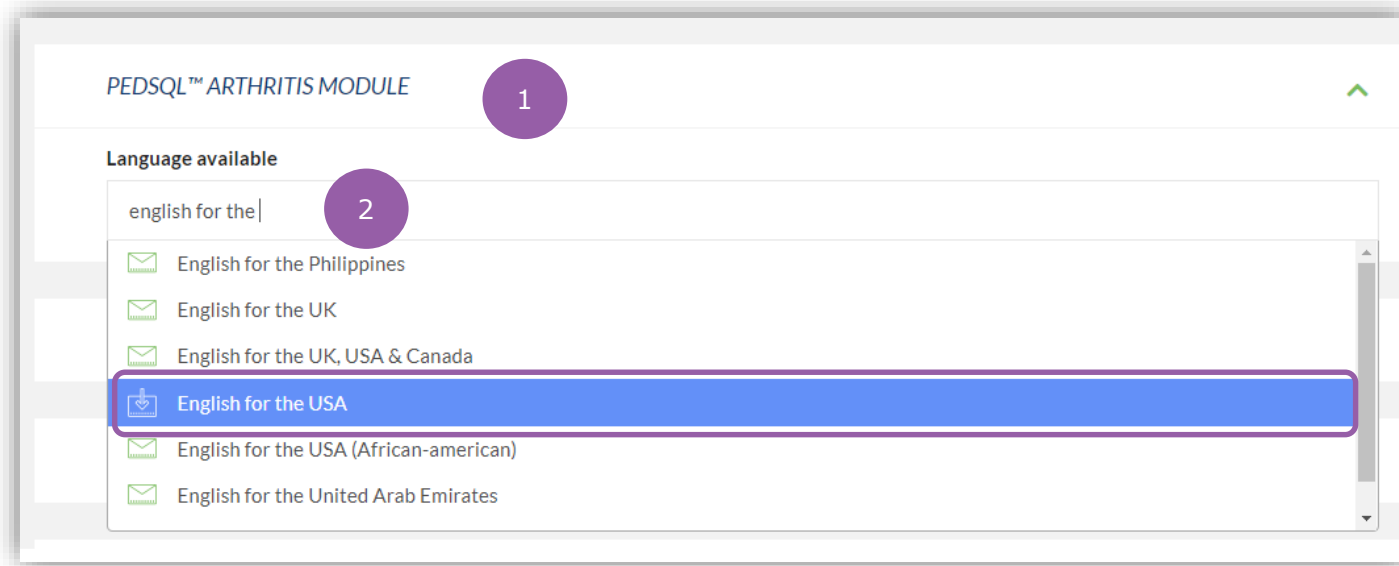

Step 5: Choose a language version

1. Click the needed version/module to unfold it
2. Select a language **for one specific country**, e.g. English for the USA

Step 6: Check your language selection

1. Select a language **for a specific country**, e.g. English for the USA instead of English
2. Avoid selecting a language for multiple countries

5. To remove a selection, click the X icon
6. Click **Next Step** down the page

As a result, MRT will not be liable for any claim brought by a Data Subject arising from any act or omission of MRT, to the extent that such act or omission is a result of the User Instructions.

If the User requires the Personal Data of MRT employees or subcontractors, the User and MRT will agree in advance as to the type of Personal Data concerning such Data Subjects to be made available. The User shall Process such Personal Data in a manner which is reasonable and in accordance Data Protection Laws.
