Step 1: Sign up for free

1. Go to <https://eprovide.mapi-trust.org/login>
2. If you already have an account, enter your credentials and click **Login**
3. If you are not registered yet, click **Free Registration**. Then complete and submit the registration form

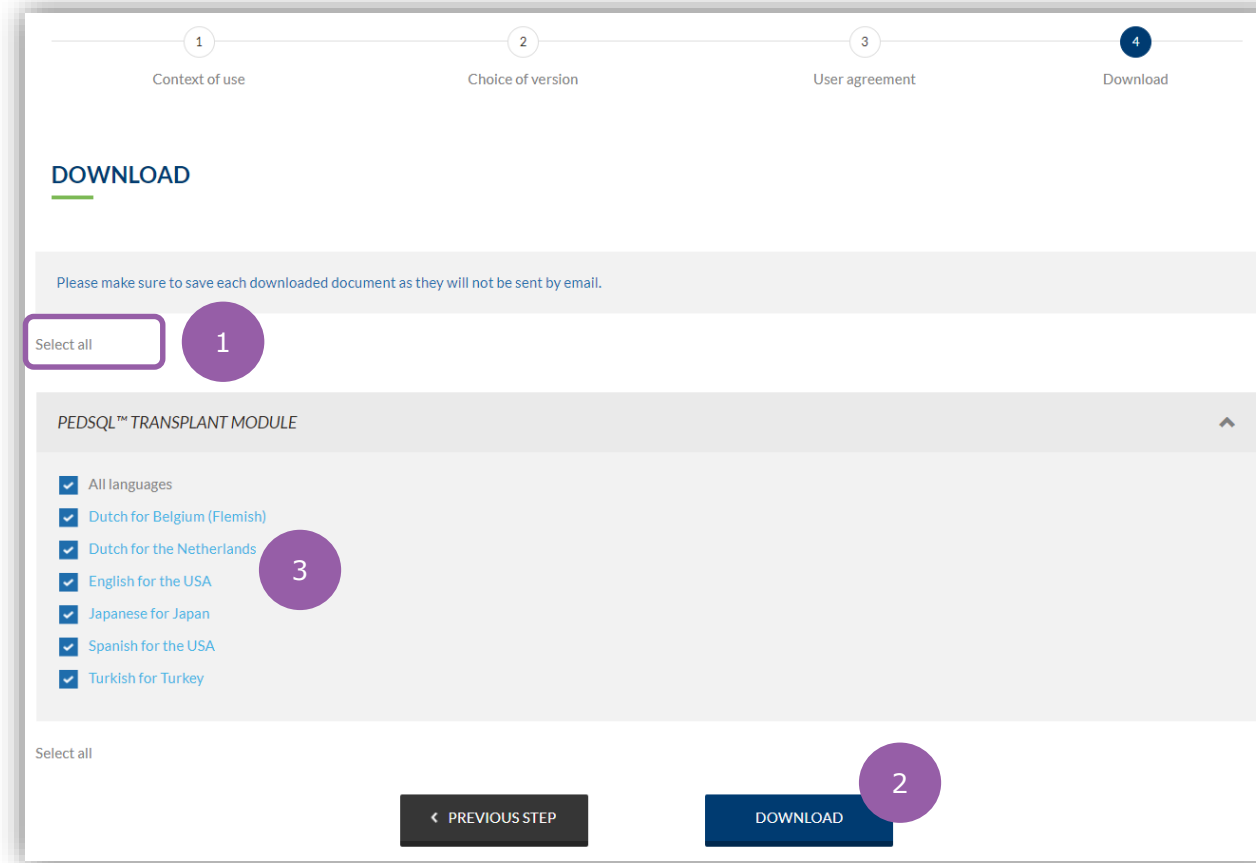
1. Click **Download User Agreement**. A PDF document will open up.
